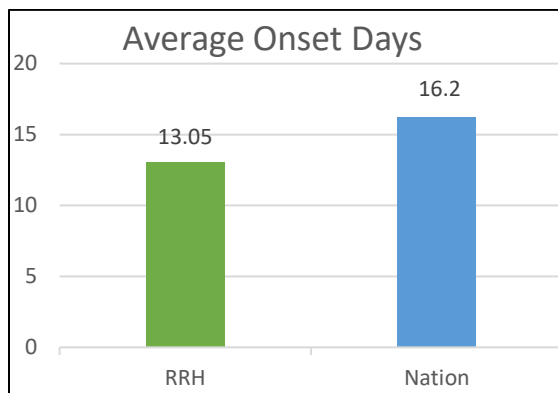


SPINAL CORD INJURY OUTCOME DATA REPORT 2017

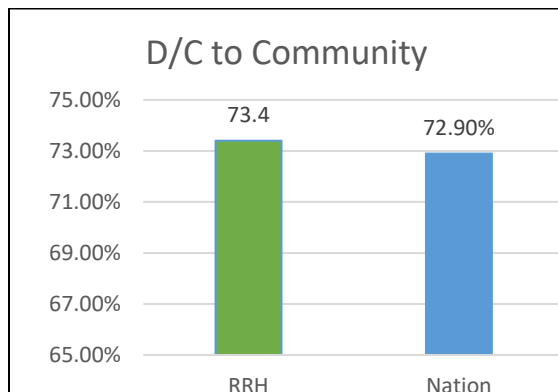
Outcome comparison between Riverside Rehabilitation Hospital and other rehabilitation hospitals in the nation

(This includes both traumatic and non-traumatic spinal cord injuries)

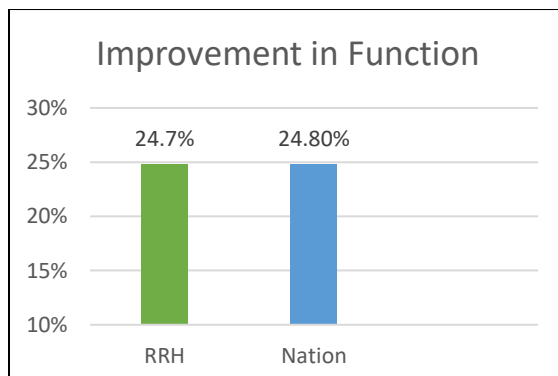
64 SCI patients were treated in 2017



Compared to the nation, we admitted patients almost 3 days sooner. Collaboration with case managers and attendance at RRM Neuro IPOC rounds have assisted in identifying potential rehab candidates sooner. In 2017, we treated 7 more SCI patients than in 2016.



73.4% of our SCI patients were able to make enough progress during their short rehab stay (average 17 days) and return to their prior living arrangements, while continuing their rehab with outpatient or home health therapy.



Improvements in overall function from admission to discharge includes mobility (transfers, ambulation) and ADLs (toileting, bathing, dressing, grooming, etc). Our goal is to have patients return home functioning as independently as possible.
