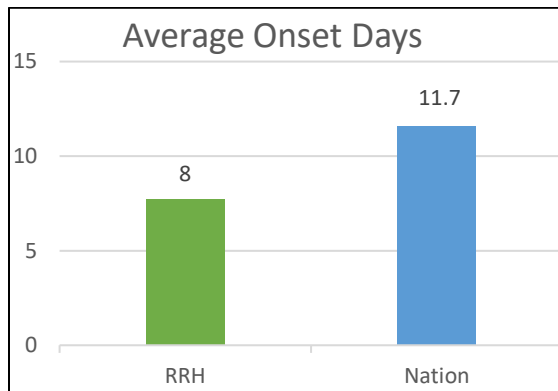

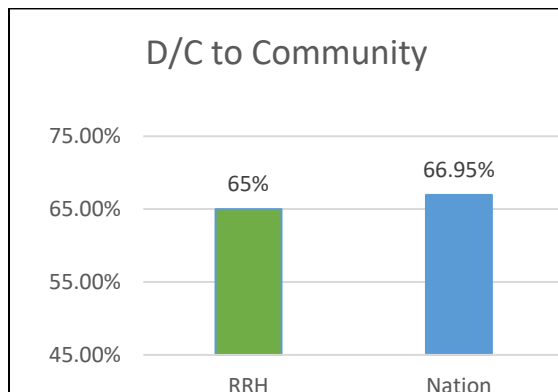

Outcome comparison between Riverside Rehabilitation Hospital and other rehabilitation hospitals in the nation

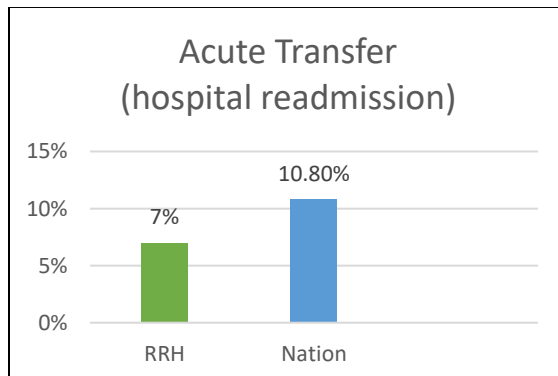
242 stroke patients were treated in 2017



Compared to the nation, we admitted patients almost 4 days sooner. Collaboration with case managers and attendance at RRM Neuro IPOC rounds have assisted in identifying potential rehab candidates sooner. In 2017, we treated 26 more stroke patients than in 2016.



65% of our stroke patients were able to make enough progress during their short rehab stay and return to their prior living arrangements, while continuing their rehab with outpatient or home health therapy.



Only 7% of our stroke patients were sent back to the hospital for acute medical reasons during their inpatient rehab stay. This is noteworthy, especially since we admitted patients sooner and with more medical complexities compared to the nation.
